Status Decision – C.U.P.S.

CRITICAL - RESPIRATORY ARREST – CARDIAC ARREST

UNSTABLE - AIRWAY UNOPENED – SUSTAINED,

- BREATHING DIFFICULTIES, - SERIOUS HEAD INJURIES,

- CHEST INJURIES, - UNCONTROLLED BLEEDING WITH SIGNS OF SHOCK,

- CRUSHING CHEST PAIN.

POTENTIALLY UNSTABLE - REQUIRING SECONDARY SURVEY,

- COMPENSATED SHOCK MECHANISM OF INJURY SUGGESTS HIDDEN COMPLICATIONS, - INJURY TO EXTREMITIES WITH NERVE, CIRCULATOR

DAMAGE.

STABLE – MINOR ASSOCIATED INJURIES WITHOUT, - MAJOR BLOOD LOSS, NERV
